The Washington College Grant (WA Grant) is state financial aid that gives people money for education beyond high school.

It is not a loan—it is free money for education or training that does not have to be paid back.

For more people

Some people assume that they won't be eligible for any financial aid because their family makes too much money, or because they didn't do well in high school, or are undocumented. That's not the case.

WA Grant is available to the following people:

- Washington residents (including undocumented people)
- Recent high school graduates or working-age adults
- Individuals from low-to middle-income households
- People who plan to attend an approved certificate program, job training, apprenticeship, or college, part-time or full-time
